On some alternative routes, you may need to purchase a ticket and apply for a refund\*. Full details of where your ticket will be accepted will be available on our websites during times of disruption.

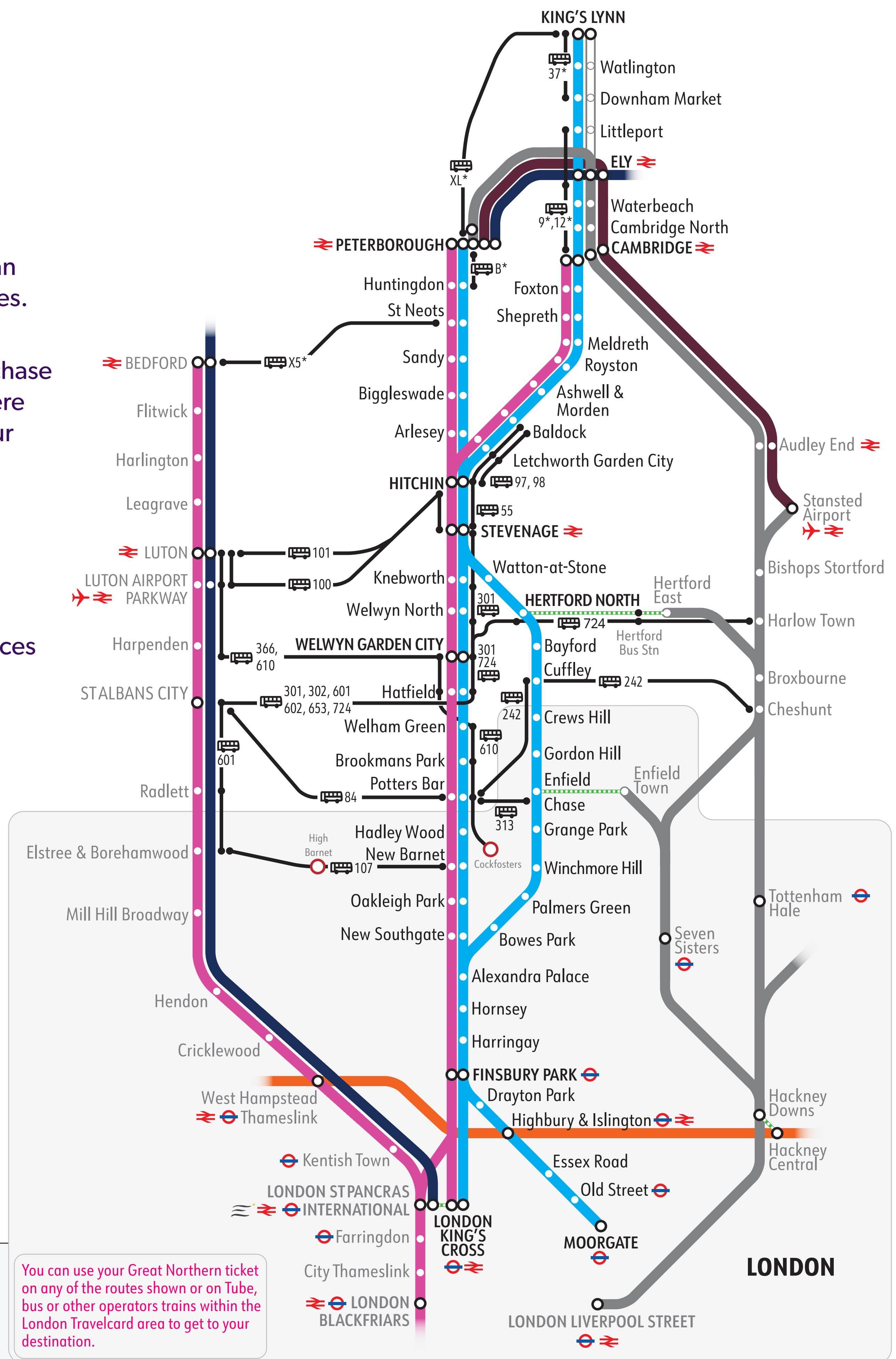
