Flitwick, Harlington	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; bus E# Mondays to Fridays only (from stand 10) to Toddington; bus 42# to your destination or bus AF (from stand 10) to Houghton Regis (Morrisons stop M2); bus 30AF Saturdays only to Toddington; bus 42# to your destination
Leagrave	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; then walk (3 minutes) to Luton (Silver Street) via footpath towards town centre and Bute Street; bus 23#, 27#, 28# to Leagrave

Alternatively bus 63 (from south exit stop C or north exit stop J) to Farringdon station; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Baker Street; then Green Line Coach 757 (from Baker Street/Dorset Square stop S) to Luton Station Interchange
Luton Airport Parkway	Bus 63 (from south exit stop C or north exit stop J) to King's Cross; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 (from stop N) to Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. Alternatively bus 63 (from south exit stop C or north exit stop J) to Farringdon station; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Baker Street; then Green Line Coach 757 to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath

Cricklewood	Circle/District line to Monument/Bank; Northern line to Golders Green; bus 245, 260 (from stops GA/GB) to Cricklewood
West Hampstead Thameslink	Circle/District line to Westminster; Jubilee line to West Hampstead
Kentish Town	Circle/District line to Monument/Bank; Northern line to Kentish Town
London St Pancras International	Bus 45, 63 (from south exit stop C) or (north exit stop J) to St Pancras International
Farringdon	Bus 63 (from south exit stop C) or (north exit stop J) to Farringdon
City Thameslink	Use the north side exit; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to City Thameslink
London Bridge	Circle/District line to Monument/Bank; Northern line or walk (5 minutes) across London Bridge to London Bridge station

Eynsford	Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Swanley; walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley (High Street) via Station Approach and Godsel Road; bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays or bus 429# Sundays only (from outside Swanley station on Azalea Drive) to Eynsford or taxi from Swanley station to Eynsford
Shoreham	Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Swanley; then walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley (High Street) via Station Approach and Godsel Road; bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays only to Shoreham or taxi from Swanley station to Shoreham
Otford	Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Otford
Bat & Ball	Circle/District line to Embankment; Southeastern train from Charing Cross to Sevenoaks; bus 8#, 306#, 308#, 421# (from stop adjacent to Sevenoaks station on London Road) or bus 452# (from stop opposite Sevenoaks station on London Road) via Otford Road and Bat & Ball Road to Bat & Ball station
Sevenoaks	Circle/District line to Embankment; Southeastern train from Charing Cross to Sevenoaks

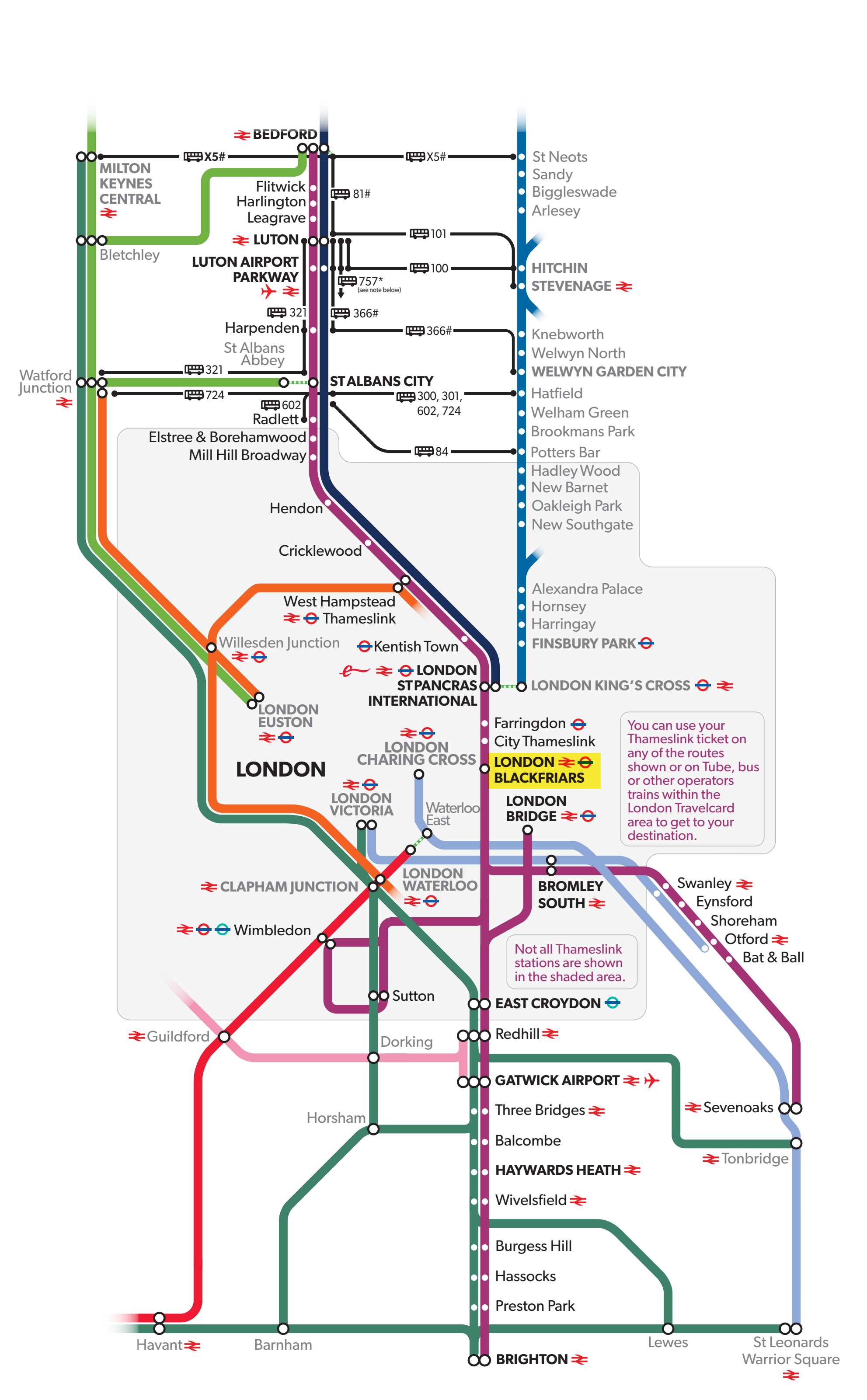

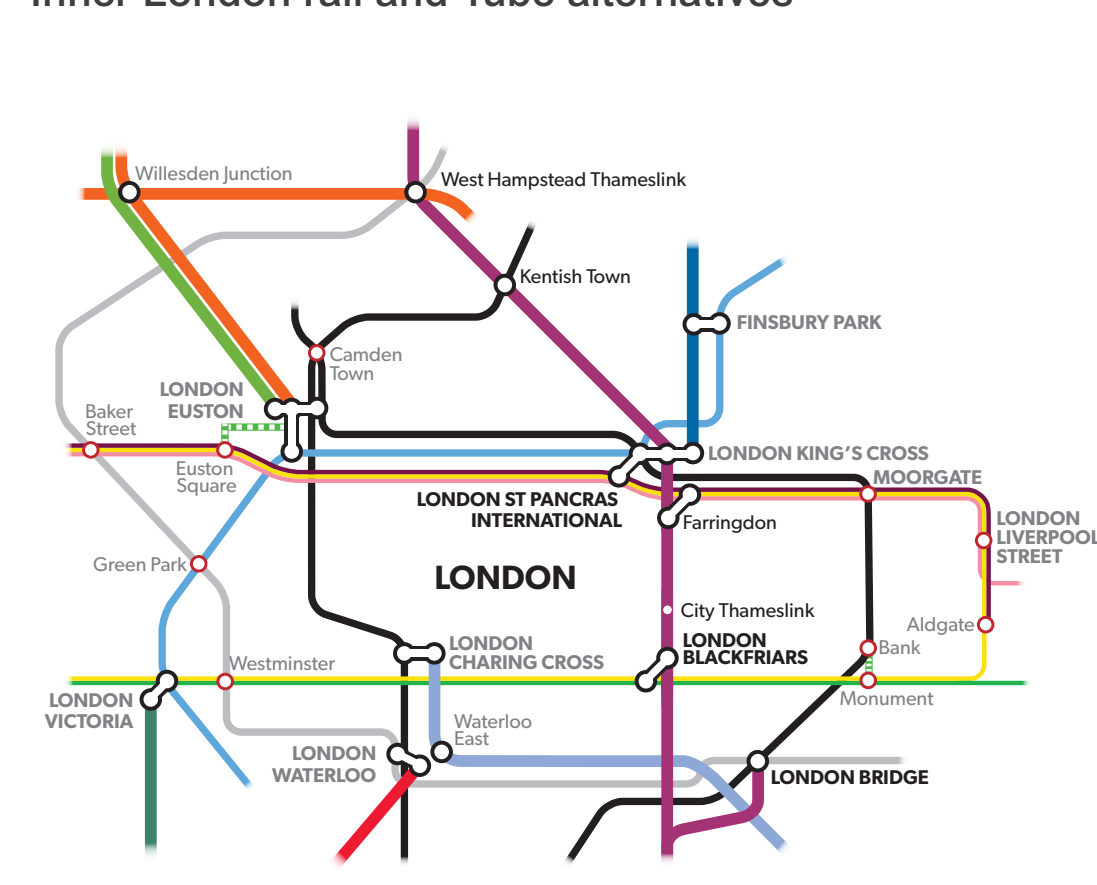
