Bedford	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to Euston; London Midland train to Bletchley; London Midland train to Bedford St Johns (not Sundays) or London Midland train to Milton Keynes Central; bus X5# (from stop Y4) to Bedford
Luton	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Jubilee line to Baker Street; Green Line Coach 757 (from Baker Street/Dorset Square stop S) to Luton Station Interchange. Alternatively as above to London Bridge; Northern line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 or 101 (from stop N) to Luton Station Interchange
Luton	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100, 101 (from stop N) to Luton Station Interchange
Luton Airport Parkway	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Jubilee line to Baker Street; Green Line Coach 757 (from Baker Street/Dorset Square stop S) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. Alternatively as above to London Bridge; Northern line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 (from stop N) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath
St Albans City	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Hatfield; bus 300, 301, 602, 724 to St Albans City
West Hampstead Thameslink	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Jubilee line to West Hampstead
Kentish Town	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to Kentish Town
London St Pancras International	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to King's Cross St Pancras
Farringdon	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to Moorgate; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Farringdon. Alternatively Southeastern train to London Bridge; Jubilee line to Southwark; bus 63 (from stop SA) to Farringdon
City Thameslink	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Cannon Street; Bus 15, 17 to City Thameslink (Ludgate Hill)
London Blackfriars	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Cannon Street; Circle/District line to Blackfriars
Elephant & Castle	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to London Bridge; Northern line to Elephant & Castle
Denmark Hill	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Lewisham; Southeastern train to Denmark Hill. Alternatively bus 185 (from stop S) direct to Denmark Hill
Peckham Rye	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Lewisham; Southeastern train to Peckham Rye
Nunhead	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Lewisham; Southeastern train to Nunhead
Crofton Park	Bus 171 (from stop S) to Crofton Park
Bellingham	Bus 171 (from stop P) to Bellingham (Catford Bus Garage) or bus 320 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bellingham (Bromley Road) or bus 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bellingham (Brookhowse Road)
Beckenham Hill	Bus 171 (from stop P) to Bellingham (Catford Bus Garage); bus 54 to Beckenham Hill, or bus 320 (from Lewisham Town Hall stop Y) to Beckenham Hill (Bromley Road The Pond stop) or bus 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Beckenham Hill (Southend Lane stop)
Ravensbourne	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Clock House; bus 354 (from stop BC) to Ravensbourne
Shortlands	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Clock House; bus 227 (from stop BC) to Shortlands
Bromley South	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South
Bickley	Bus 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bickley
St Mary Cray	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to St Mary Cray
Swanley	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Swanley
Eynsford	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Swanley; walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley (High Street) via Station Approach and Godsel Road; bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays or bus 429# limited service Sundays only (from outside Swanley station on Azalea Drive) to Eynsford or from Swanley to Eynsford
Shoreham	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Swanley; then walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley (High Street) via Station Approach and Godsel Road; bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays only to Shoreham or taxi from Swanley station to Shoreham.
Otford	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Otford
Bat & Ball	Bus 320, 336 (from Thomas Lane stop Q) to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Orpington; Southeastern train to Sevenoaks; bus 8#, 306#, 308#, 421# (from stop adjacent to Sevenoaks station on London Road) or bus 452# (from stop opposite Sevenoaks station on London Road) via Otford Road and Bat and Ball Road to Bat & Ball station
Sevenoaks	Go to Catford Bridge station; Southeastern train to Lewisham; Southeastern train to Orpington; Southeastern train to Sevenoaks

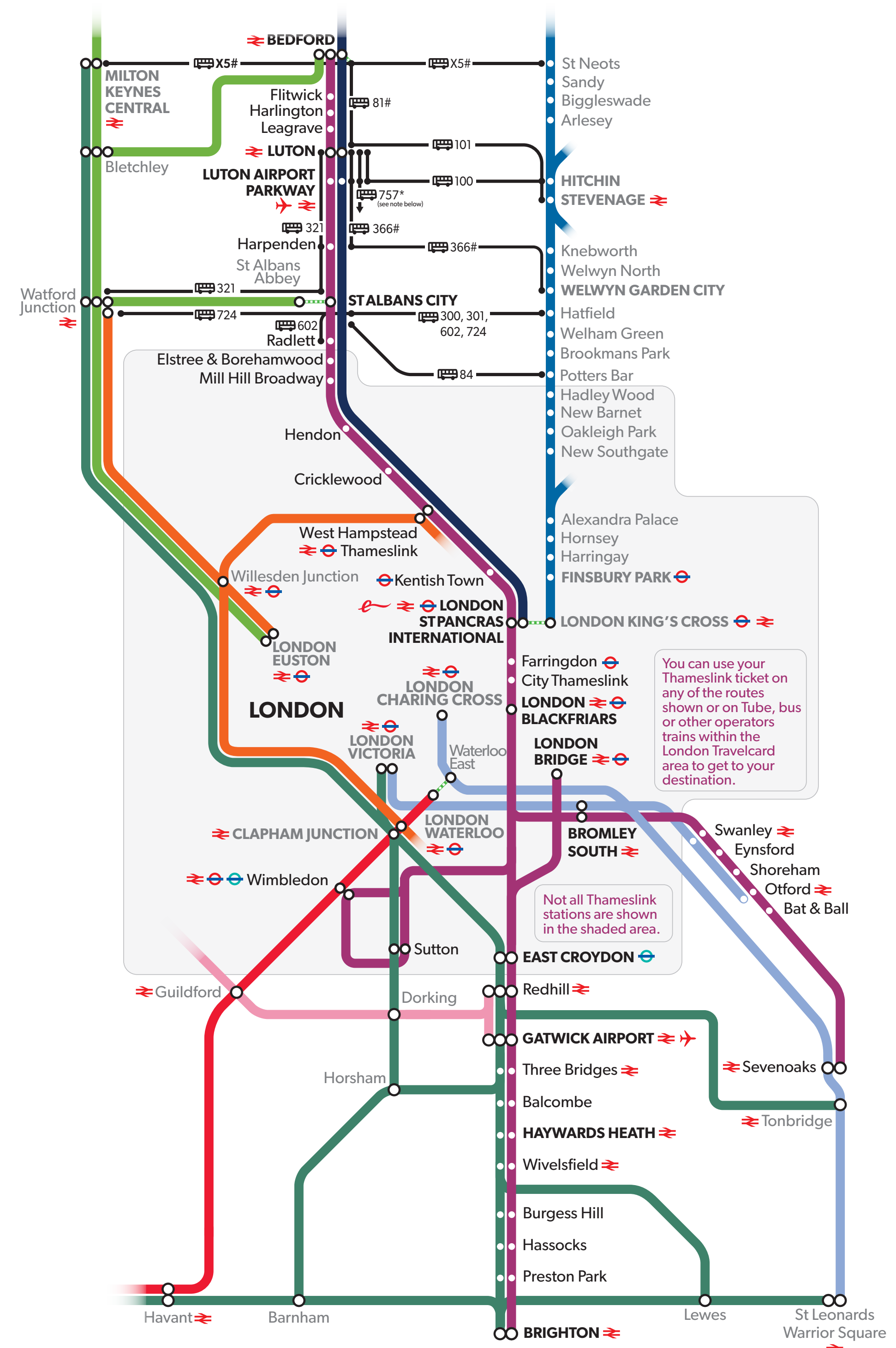

Delay Repay

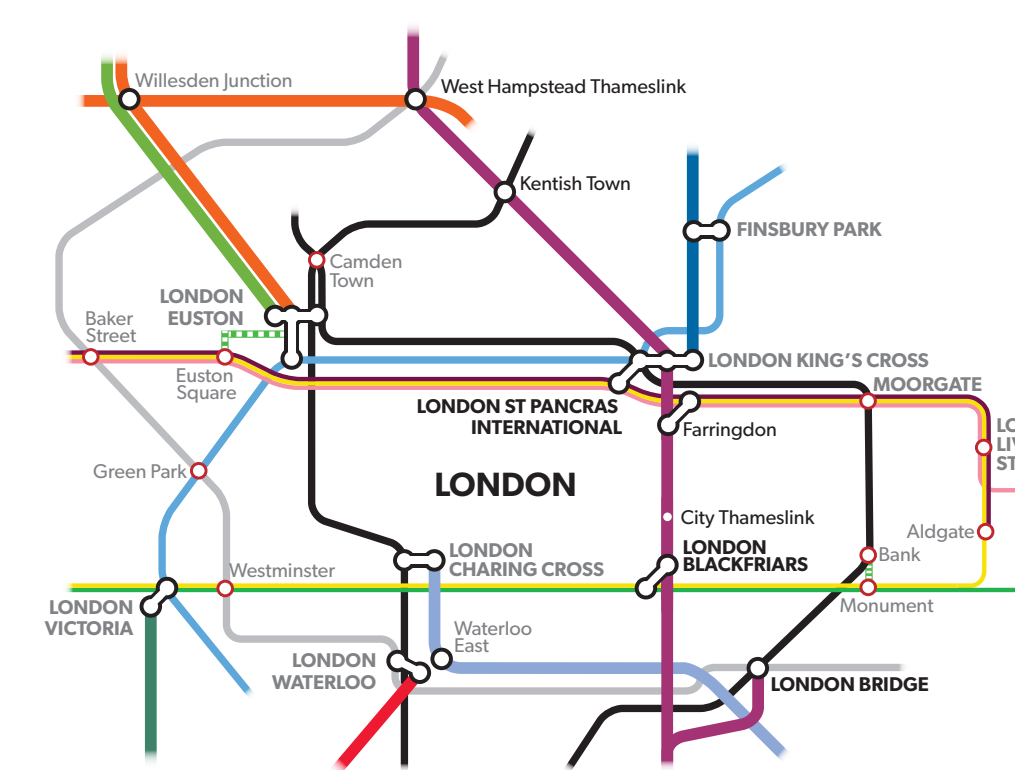
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
