Bedford	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to Farringdon; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Euston Square (for Euston); London Midland train to Bletchley; London Midland train to Bedford St Johns (not Sundays) or London Midland train to Milton Keynes Central; bus X5# (from stop Y4) to Bedford
Flitwick, Harlington	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; bus E# Mondays to Fridays only (from stand 10) to Toddington; bus 42# to your destination or bus Air (from stand 10) to Houghton Regis (Morrison's stop M2); bus 38A# Saturdays only to Toddington; bus 42# to your destination
Leagrave	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; then walk (3 minutes) to Luton (Silver Street) via footpath towards town centre and Bute Street; 23, 27, 28 to Leagrave
Luton	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100, 101 (from stop N) to Luton Station Interchange. Alternatively exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to Farringdon; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Baker Street; then Green Line Coach 757 (from Baker Street/Dorset Square stop S) to Luton Station Interchange
Luton Airport Parkway	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 (from stop N) to Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. Alternatively Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to Farringdon; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Baker Street; then Green Line Coach 757 (from Baker Street/Dorset Square stop S) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath
Harpenden	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Great Northern train to Welwyn Garden City; bus 366# (Mondays to Fridays only) or Great Northern train to Hatfield; bus 300, 301, 602, 724 to St Albans (St Peter's Street); then bus 321, 657 to Harpenden or see below how to get to St Albans City; then bus 321 or 657 to Harpenden

Radlett	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Edgware; bus 107, 292 (from stop F) to Elstree & Borehamwood; bus 655 (from Shenley Street stop G) then walk (6 minutes/0.3 miles) to Radlett
Elstree & Borehamwood	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Edgware; bus 107, 292 (from stop F) to Elstree & Borehamwood
Mill Hill Broadway	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Burnt Oak; bus 114, 251 (from stop M) to Bunn's Lane; then walk (4 minutes/0.2 miles) to Mill Hill Broadway
Hendon	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Hendon Central; walk (13 minutes/0.6 miles) via Vivian Street and Station Road or bus 83 (from stop B) to Hendon station
Cricklewood	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Golders Green; bus 245, 260 (from stops GA/GB) to Cricklewood
West Hampstead Thameslink	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to Farringdon; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Baker Street; Jubilee line to West Hampstead
Kentish Town	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to King's Cross; Northern line to Kentish Town
London St Pancras International	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) to St Pancras International
Farringdon	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop M on Farringdon Street) or walk (8 minutes/0.4 miles) to Farringdon
London Blackfriars	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars
London Bridge	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 17 (from stop G on Ludgate Hill) to London Bridge
Elephant & Castle	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63, 100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 154 (from stop M) to St Helier
Loughborough Junction	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 80 (from stop H), 154 (from stop C or H), 93 (from stop A) to Morden South

Sutton Common	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 164 (from stop B) to Cranleigh Gardens; walk (5 minutes/0.2 miles) via Angel Hill and Sutton Common Road to Sutton Common station
St Helier	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 154 (from stop M) to St Helier
Morden South	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 80 (from stop H), 154 (from stop C or H), 93 (from stop A) to Morden South
South Merton	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Morden; bus 164, 413 (from stop F) to South Merton
Wimbledon Chase	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 4, 26/76 (from stop F on Ludgate Hill) to Waterloo; South West Trains to Wimbledon; bus 164 (from stop D) to Wimbledon Chase
Wimbledon	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 4, 26/76 (from stop F on Ludgate Hill) to Waterloo; South West Trains to Wimbledon
Haydons Road	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 4, 26/76 (from stop F on Ludgate Hill) to Waterloo; South West Trains to Wimbledon; bus 200 (from stop J) to Haydons Road
Tooting	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; Northern line to Tooting Broadway; walk (13 minutes/0.7 miles) via Mitcham Road or bus 264, 270, 280, 355 (from stop E) to Tooting station
Denmark Hill	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63, 100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Elephant & Castle; bus 40, 68, 176, 468 (from stop R) to Denmark Hill. Alternatively, exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Denmark Hill
Peckham Rye	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Peckham Rye, or bus 17 (from stop G on Ludgate Hill) to London Bridge; Southern train to Peckham Rye. Alternatively, exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Peckham Rye
Nunhead	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 63 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Peckham Rye, or bus 17 (from stop G on Ludgate Hill) to London Bridge; Southern train to Peckham Rye; Southeastern train or bus 78, P12 from Peckham Rye (stop V) to Nunhead. Alternatively, exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Nunhead
Crofton Park	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 45, 63/100 (from stop K on New Bridge Street) to Blackfriars; District line to Whitechapel; London Overground train to Brockley; bus 171, 172 (from stop BB on Brockley Road) to Crofton Park
Catford	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 15, 17 (from stop G on Ludgate Hill) to Cannon Street; Southeastern train to Catford Bridge
Bellingham	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 15, 17 (from stop G on Ludgate Hill) to Cannon Street; Southeastern train to Lewisham; bus 136, 208 (from stop B) to Bellingham (Bellingham Road stop)
Beckenham Hill	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Beckenham Junction; bus 54 (from High Street stop C) to Beckenham Hill
Ravensbourne	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Beckenham Junction; bus 354 (from High Street stop C) to Ravensbourne
Shorlands, Bromley South, Bickley, St Mary Cray, Swanley	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to your destination
Eynsford	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Swansley; walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Eynsford (High Street); bus 42# limited service Mondays to Saturdays or bus 42# limited service Sundays only (from outside Swanley station on Azalea Drive) to Eynsford or taxi from Swanley station to Eynsford
Shoreham	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Swanley; then walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley (High Street); bus 42# limited service Mondays to Saturdays only to Shoreham or taxi from Swanley station to Shoreham
Oxford	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southeastern train to Oxford
Bat & Ball	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 11, 15, 23 (from stop F on Ludgate Hill) to Charing Cross; Southeastern train to Sevenoaks; bus #9, 306#, 309#, 421# (from stop adjacent to Sevenoaks station on London Road) or bus 452# (from stop opposite Sevenoaks station on London Road) via Otford Road and Bat and Ball Road to Bat & Ball station
Sevenoaks	Exit via Ludgate Hill; bus 11, 15, 23 (from stop F on Ludgate Hill) to Charing Cross; Southeastern train to Sevenoaks
East Croydon, Purley, Coulsdon South, Merstham, Redhill, Gatwick Airport, Three Bridges, Balcombe, Haywards Heath, Wivelsfield, Burgess Hill, Hassocks, Preston Park, Brighton	Exit via Ludgate Hill; 5 minutes walk along New Bridge Street to Blackfriars; Circle/District line to Victoria; Southern train to your destination

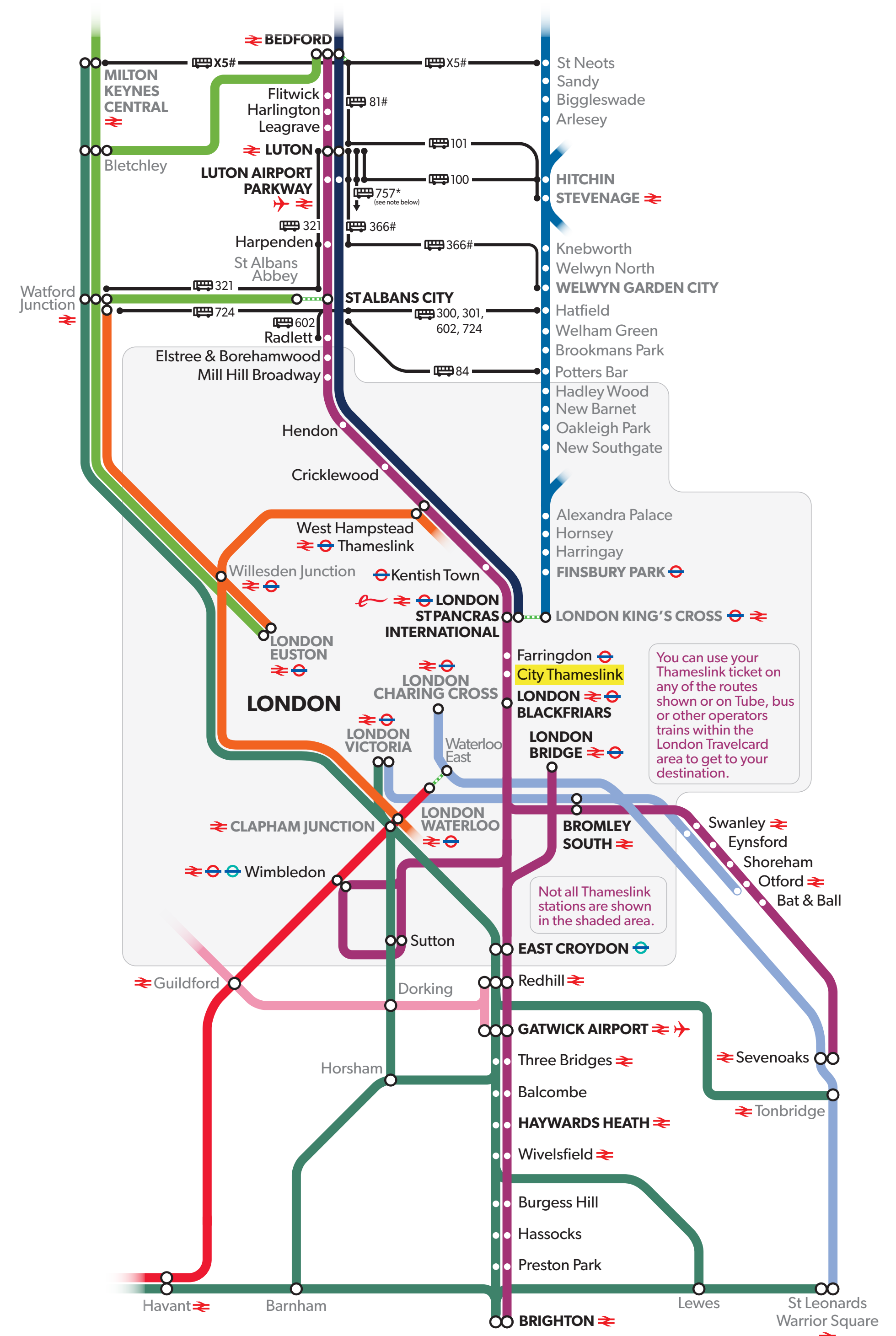

Delay Repay

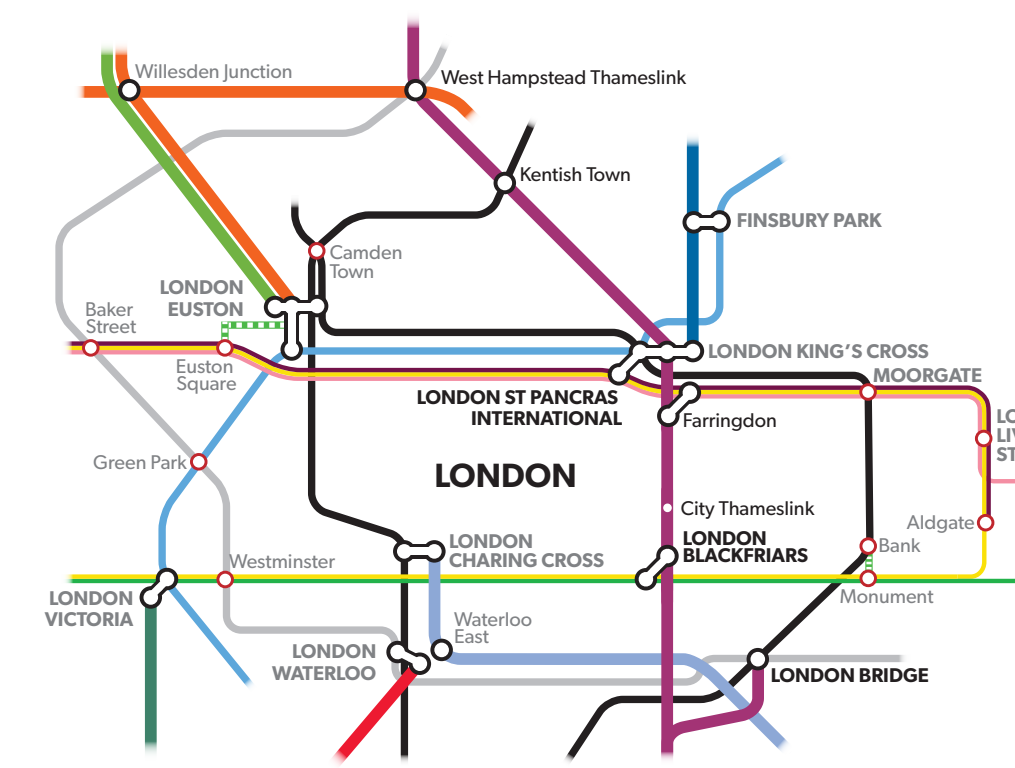
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
