Bedford	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; London Midland train to Bletchley; London Midland train to Bedford St Johns (not Sundays) or London Midland train to Milton Keynes Central; bus X5# (from stop Y4) to Bedford
Luton	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to London Victoria; Green Line Coach 757 (from stop 11*) to Luton Station Interchange. Alternatively from London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100, 101 (from stop N) to Luton Station Interchange. (* Stop 11 is opposite Victoria Station exit on Buckingham Palace Road)
Luton Airport Parkway	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to London Victoria; Green Line Coach 757 (from stop 11*) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. Alternatively from London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 (from stop N) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. (* Stop 11 is opposite Victoria Station exit on Buckingham Palace Road)

Catford	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; bus 320, 336 (from stop A) to Catford
Bellingham	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; bus 208, 320 (from stop A) to Bellingham (Catford Bus Garage)
Beckenham Hill	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; bus 208/320 (from stop A) to Bromley Road The Pond (stop SV) walk (5 minutes/0.3 miles, via Beckenham Hill Road) to Beckenham Hill
Ravensbourne	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Beckenham Junction; bus 354 (from High Street stop C) to Ravensbourne
Shortlands	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; Southeastern train to Shortlands
Bromley South	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South
Bickley	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to Bromley South; Southeastern train back to Bickley
St Mary Cray	See below for details of how to get to Swanley; then Southeastern train to St Mary Cray
Swanley	Bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays only (from stop opposite Eynsford station on Station Road/A225) to Swanley (High Street); walk (9 minutes/0.5 miles) to Swanley station via Godsel Road and Station Approach; bus 429# Sundays only (from opposite Eynsford station on Station Road/A225) to Swanley. Alternatively taxi to Swanley station
Shoreham, Otford, Bat & Ball, Sevenoaks	Bus 421# limited service Mondays to Saturdays only (from stop adjacent to Eynsford Station on Station Road/A225) to your destination or a taxi from Eynsford station to your destination.

- On bus routes marked # in the table above you may have to buy a bus ticket and apply for a refund. The routes listed above are only suggestions. Your ticket will also be accepted on services of the following operators to get to your destination:

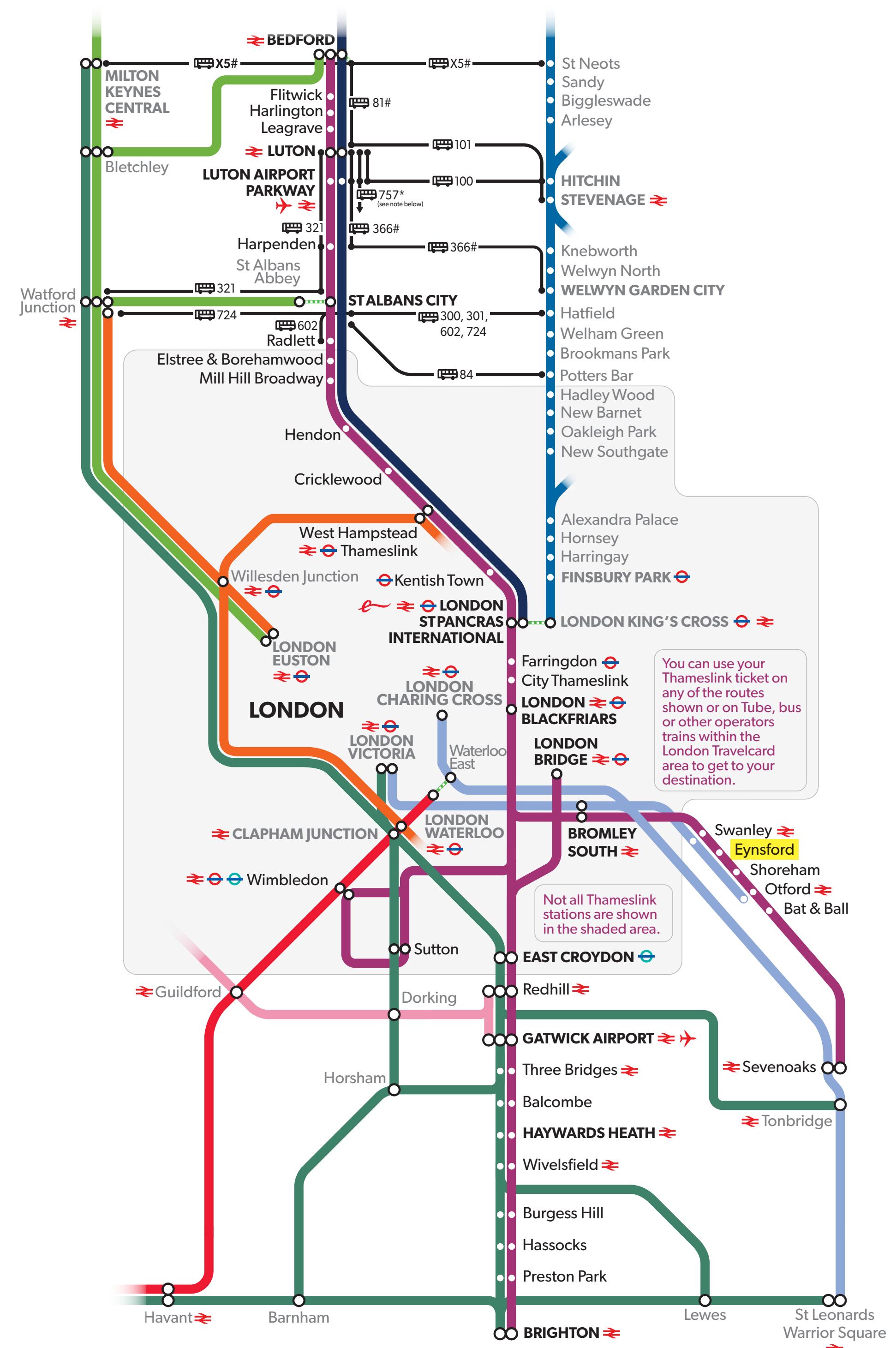

Delay Repay

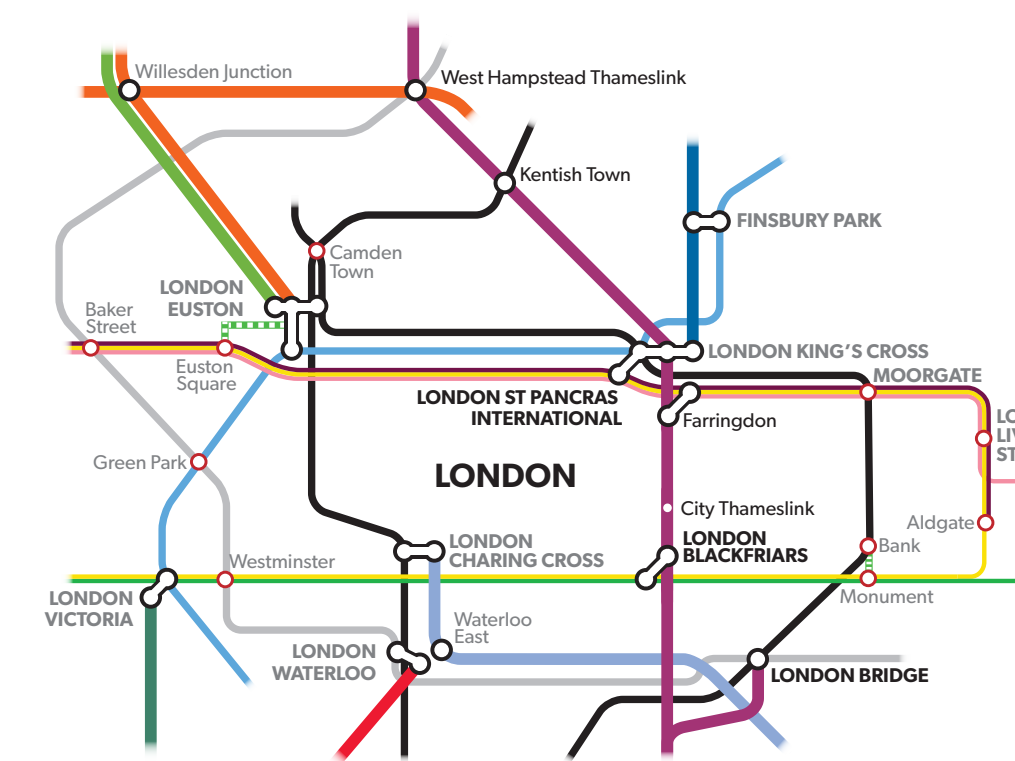
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
