Bedford	Bus 42# to Bedford bus station; walk (9 minutes/0.4 miles) via Greyfriars, Alexandra Place, Alexandra Road and Woburn Road to Bedford railway station
Harlington	Bus 42# to Harlington
Leagrave	If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your own way to an alternative station
Luton	Bus 42# to Toddington; bus E# Mondays to Fridays only to Luton Station Interchange or bus 38A Saturdays only to Houghton Regis (Morrisons stop M1); then bus A# to Luton Station Interchange
Luton Airport Parkway	Bus 42# to Toddington; bus E# Mondays to Fridays only to Luton Station Interchange; bus A# to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath or bus 42# to Toddington; bus 38A Saturdays only to Houghton Regis (Morrisons stop M1); then bus A# to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath

East Croydon, Purley, Coulsdon South, Merstham, Redhill, Gatwick Airport, Three Bridges, Balcombe, Haywards Heath, Wivelsfield, Burgess Hill, Hassocks, Preston Park, Brighton	See below for arrangements on how to get to Luton † or if no replacement buses are available, see above how to get to Luton Station Interchange; Green Line Line Coach 757 to London Victoria (Green Line Coach Station); walk (5 minutes) to London Victoria railway station; then Southern train to your destination.

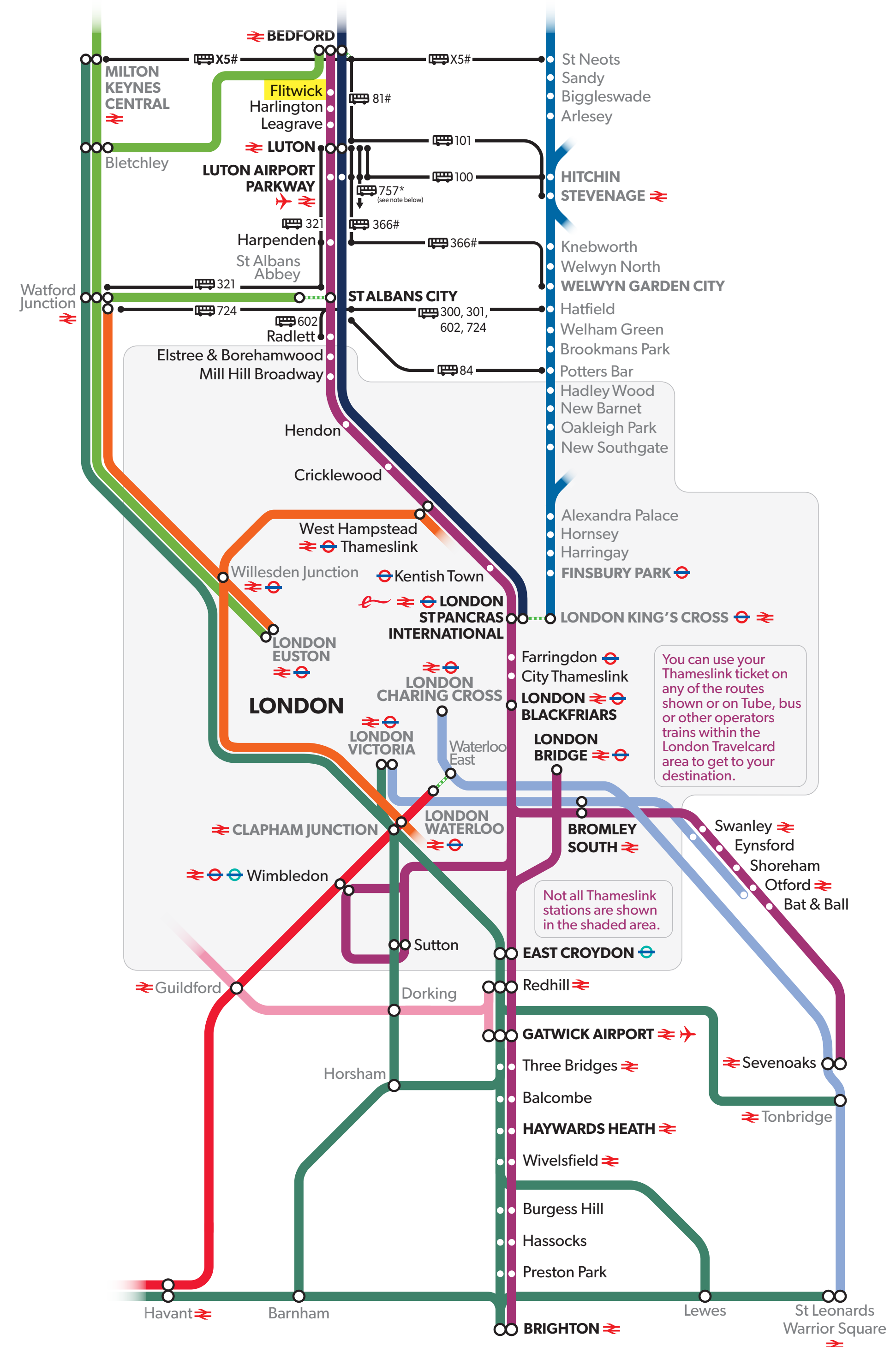

Delay Repay

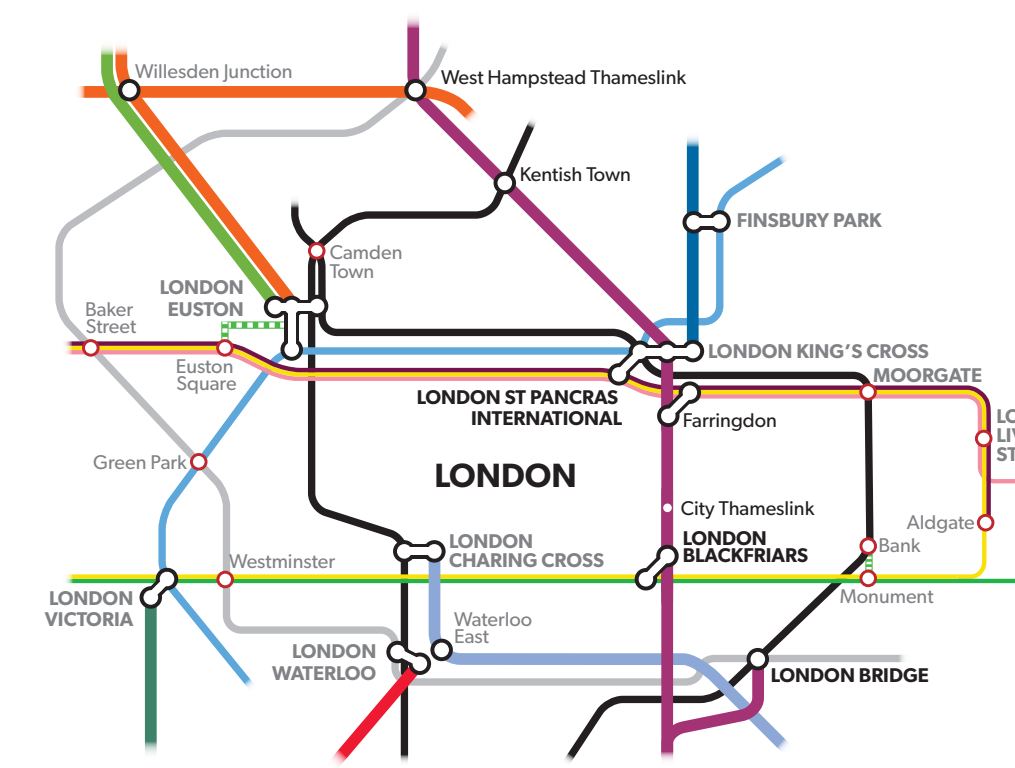
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
