Bedford	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; London Midland train to Bletchley; London Midland train to Bedford (not Sundays) or London Midland train to Milton Keynes Central; bus X5# (from stop Y4) to Bedford. Alternatively, Southern train to Clapham Junction; Southern train to Bletchley; London Midland train to Bedford (not Sundays) or Southern train to Milton Keynes Central; bus X5# (from stop Y4) to Bedford
Flitwick, Harlington	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; then bus E# Mondays to Fridays only (from stand 10) to Toddington; then bus 42# to your destination or bus A# (from stand 10) to Houghton Regis (Morrisons stop M2); bus 38A Saturdays only to Toddington; then bus 42# to your destination
Leagrave	See below how to get to Luton Station Interchange; then walk (4 minutes) to Luton (Silver Street) via footpath towards town centre and Bute Street; bus 23#, 27#, 28# to Leagrave
Luton	Southern train to London Victoria; Green Line Coach 757 (from stop 11*) to Luton Station Interchange. Alternatively from London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100, 101 (from stop N) to Luton Station Interchange. (* Stop 11 is opposite Victoria Station on Buckingham Palace Road)
Luton Airport Parkway	Southern train to London Victoria; Green Line Coach 757 (from stop 11*) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) to Luton Airport Parkway station via adjoining footpath. Alternatively from London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Stevenage; bus 100 (from stop N) to Luton Hampton Hotel; walk (2 minutes) via adjoining footpath. (* Stop 11 is opposite Victoria Station exit on Buckingham Palace Road)
Harpenden	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Welwyn Garden City; bus 366# to Harpenden. Alternatively see how to get to St Albans City; then bus 321 or 657 to Harpenden
St Albans City	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Great Northern train to Hatfield; bus 300, 301, 602, 724 to St Albans City
Radlett	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Edgware; bus 107, 292 (from stop F) to Elstree & Borehamwood; bus 655 (from Shenley Road stop G) walk (6 minutes/0.3 miles) to Radlett
Elstree & Borehamwood	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Edgware; bus 107, 292 (from stop F) to Elstree & Borehamwood
Mill Hill Broadway	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Burnt Oak; bus 114, 251 (from stop M) to Bunn's Lane, then walk (4 minutes/0.2 miles) to Mill Hill Broadway
Hendon	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Hendon Central; walk (13 minutes/0.6 miles) via Vivian Street and Station Road or bus 83 (from stop B) to Hendon station
Cricklewood	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Golders Green; bus 245, 260 (from stops GA/GB) to Cricklewood
West Hampstead Thameslink	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Green Park; Jubilee line to West Hampstead
Kentish Town	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to Euston; Northern line to Kentish Town
London St Pancras International	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras
Farringdon	Southern train to London Victoria; Victoria line to King's Cross St Pancras; Circle/Hammersmith & City/Metropolitan line to Farringdon
City Thameslink	See above for details of how to get to Three Bridges †; If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your own way to an alternative station
London Blackfriars	Southern train to London Victoria; Circle/District line to Blackfriars
London Bridge	Southern train to London Bridge
East Croydon	Southern train to East Croydon OR Southern or Great Western Railway train or bus 100#, 400#, 420# or 460# (from Northbound stop on London Road) to Redhill, then bus 405# to Croydon Fairfield Halls (stop KC) and then walk (6 minutes/0.3 miles) via Park Lane and George Street to East Croydon
Purley	Southern train to Purley OR Southern or Great Western Railway train or bus 100#, 400#, 420# or 460# (from Northbound stop on London Road) to Redhill, then bus 405# to Purley (alight at Tesco for station)
Coulsdon South	Southern train to Coulsdon South OR Southern or Great Western Railway train or bus 100#, 400#, 420# or 460# (from Northbound stop on London Road) to Redhill, then bus 405# to Coulsdon South
Merstham	Southern train to Coulsdon South OR Southern or Great Western Railway train or bus 100#, 400#, 420# or 460# (from Northbound stop on London Road) to Redhill, then bus 405# to Merstham
Redhill	Southern or Great Western Railway train to Redhill OR bus 100#, 400#, 420#, 460# (from Northbound stop, on London Road) to Redhill
Three Bridges	Southern train to Three Bridges, or bus 20#, 100#, 400# (from Southbound stop, on London Road) to Three Bridges
Balcombe, Haywards Heath, Wivelsfield, Burgess Hill, Hassocks, Preston Park, Brighton	See above for details of how to get to Three Bridges †; If we are unable to run trains, we will do our best to run replacement buses, however there may be a long wait. If you are able to, we advise you to make your own way to an alternative station. Alternatively, National Express Coach (from stop on London Road) direct to Brighton York Place stop, then walk (3 minutes/0.2 miles) up Trafalgar Street to Brighton Station.

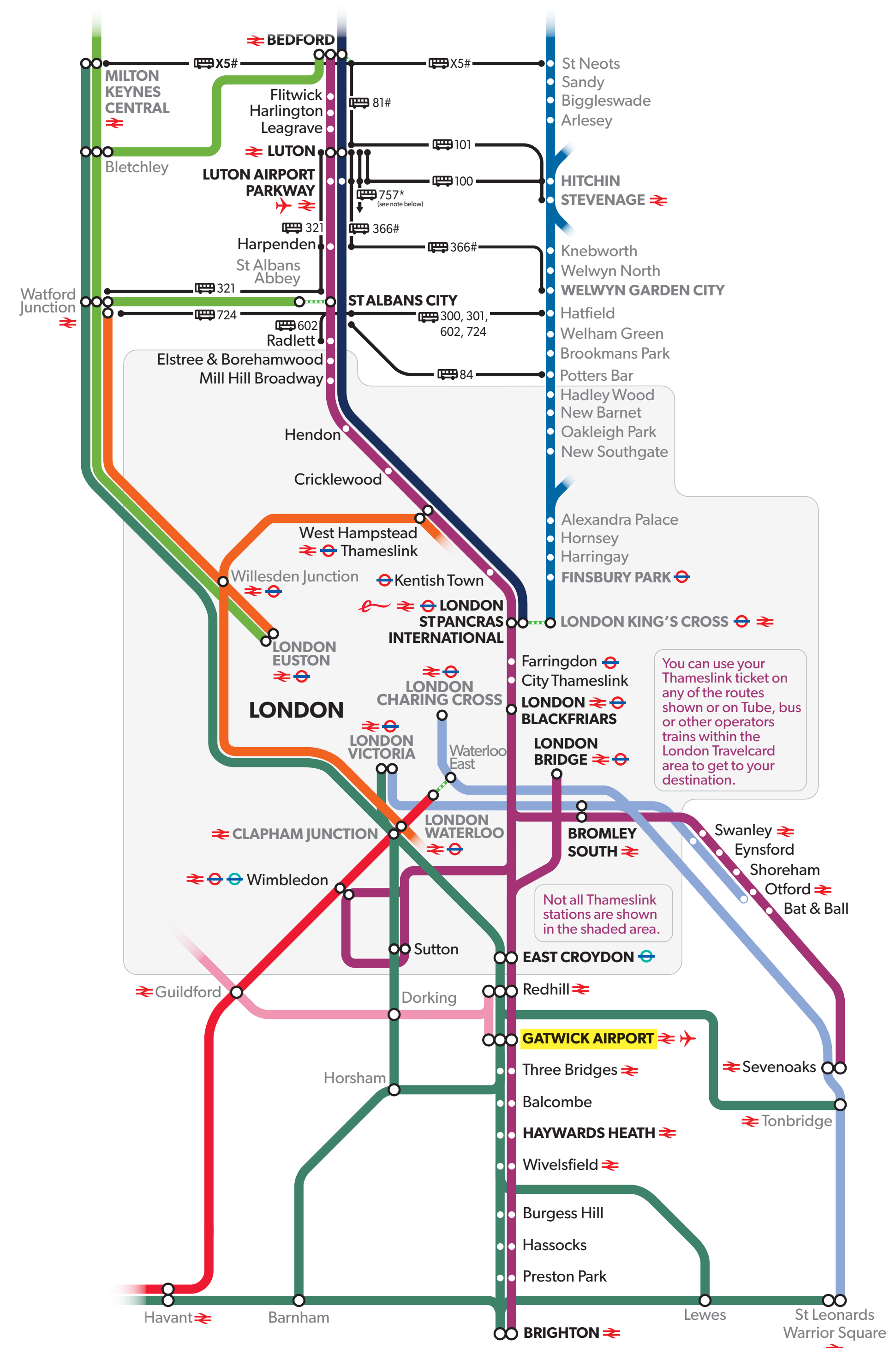

Delay Repay

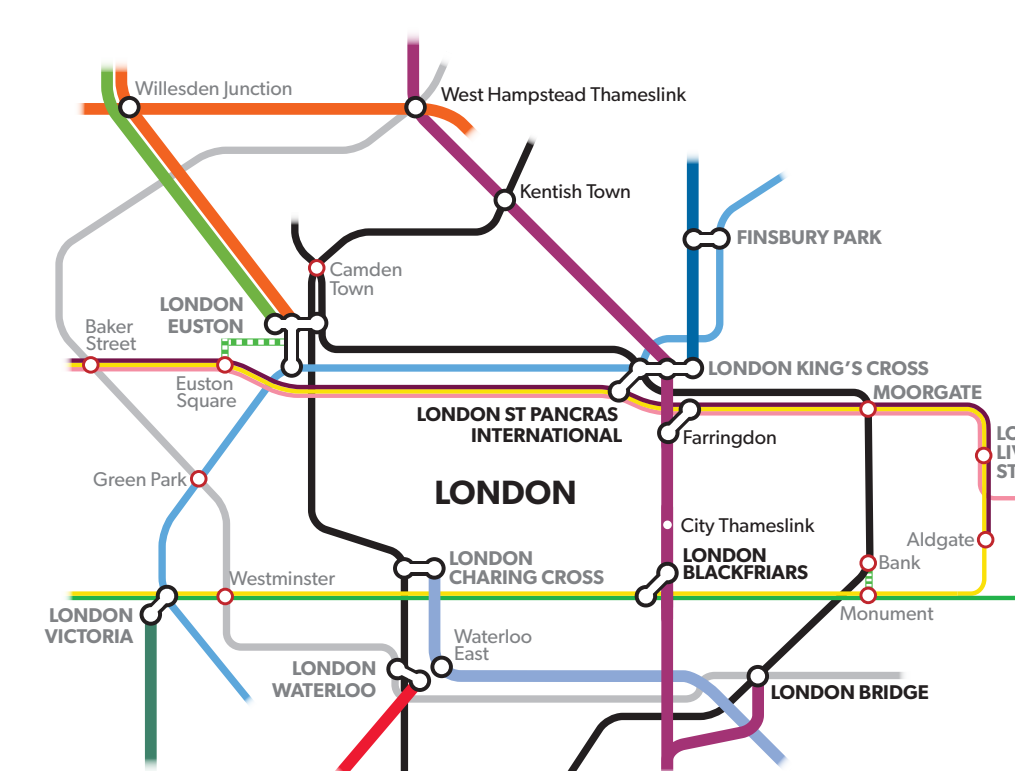
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
