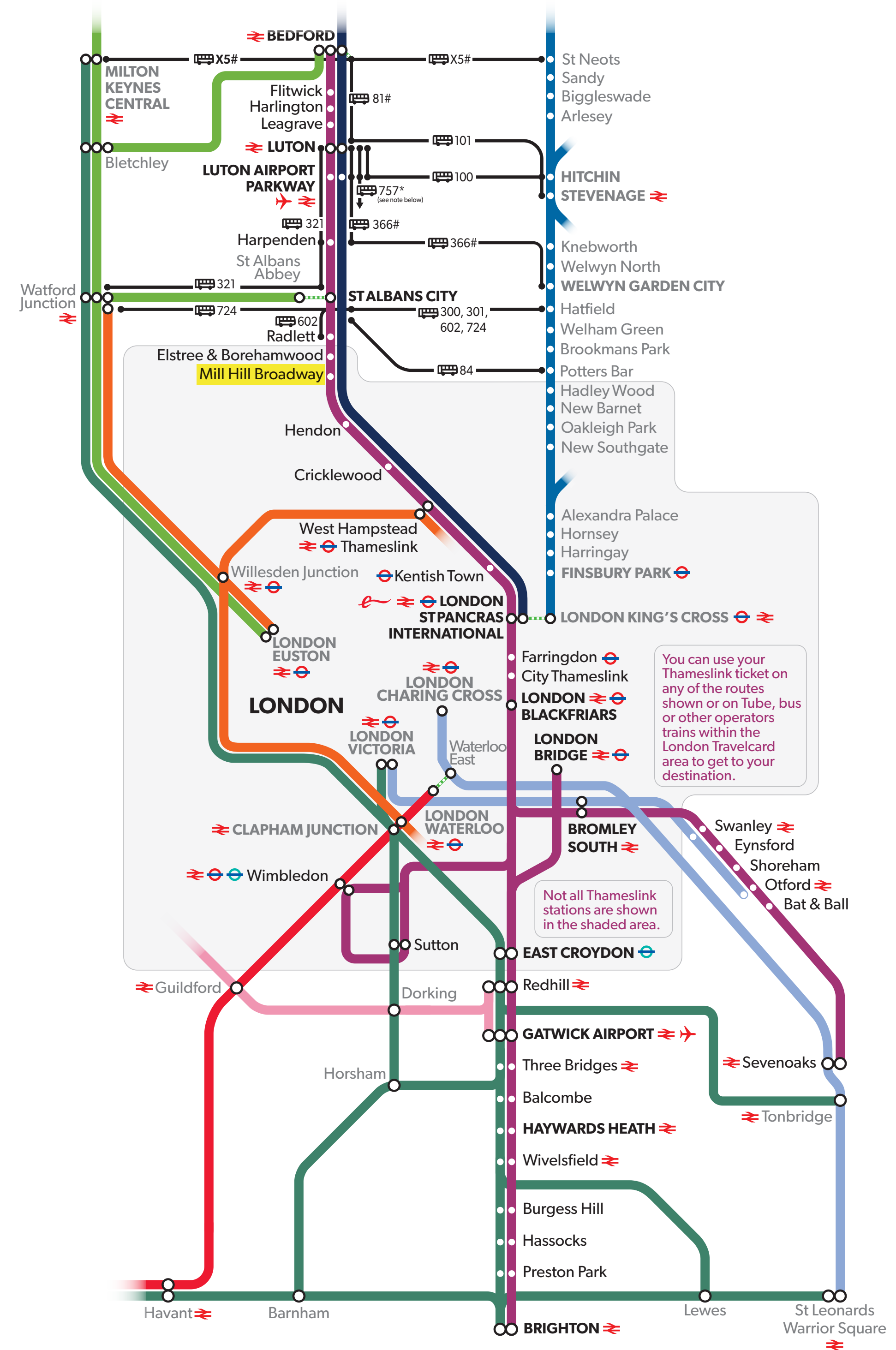

Delay Repay

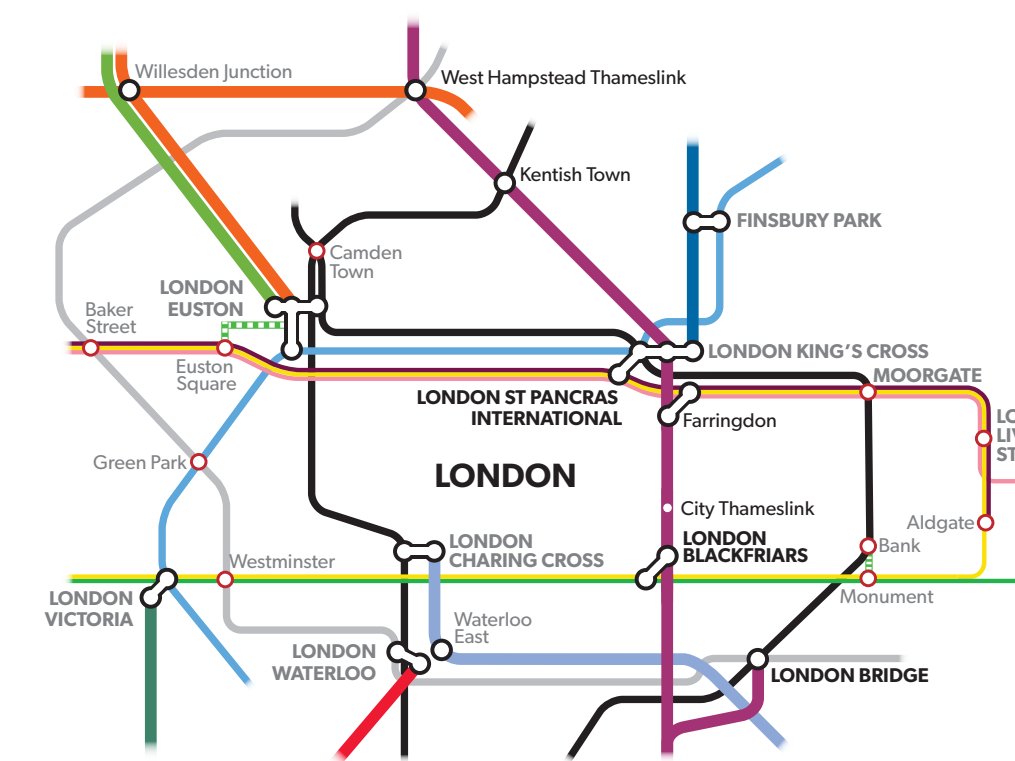
If your journey on Thameslink was delayed by 15 minutes or more, you can claim for compensation through the Delay Repay scheme.
